The Poster making competition was held on 23.09.19 in which 24 students participated displaying their creative talents and imagination, out of which one student was placed on the first position and two each on second and third position.



The Slogan writing competition was conducted on 24.09.19 in which 23 students participated citing the evils of using plastic and abuses of disposal of Polythene in the surroundings. Out of these 23 students, one each was placed on the Ist , IInd and IIIrd position and one was given consolation prize.







A demonstration of making Carry Bags with variety of papers and grocery thongas (lifafas) with brown paper and newspaper was given by Ms. Shereen Paul on 25.09.19 in which more than 50 students participated and learnt the skills of making these.
